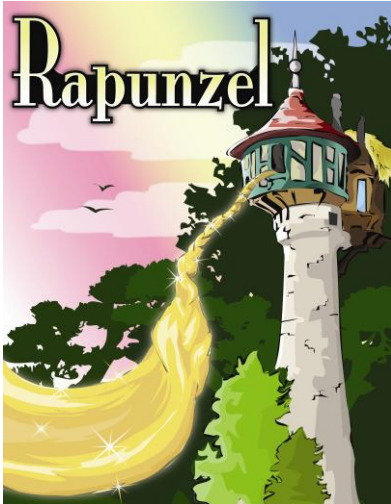




CAMP *Rapunzel*

DDP Performing Arts Academy CAMP Rapunzel FAQs

What is the date and time? Friday, June 8, 2011 from 9:30AM-2:30PM

Where do I go? The day begins and finishes in the theatre arena at Derby Dinner Playhouse. Parking is free. The classes take place on stage, in the lobby, and in the lounge.

What is the schedule for the day?

9:30AM:	Check-in, arrival and seating for performance
10:00-10:50AM:	Students watch professional production of <i>Rapunzel</i>
10:50-11:00AM:	Break
11:00-11:15AM:	Post-performance discussion with the <i>Rapunzel</i> cast
11:15-11:30AM:	Theatre tour
11:30AM-12:00PM:	Lunch (students bring own lunch)
12:00-12:30PM:	Acting, Music, or Dance
12:30-12:40PM:	Break
12:40-1:10PM:	Acting, Music, or Dance
1:10-1:20PM:	Break
1:20-1:50PM:	Acting, Music, or Dance
1:50-2:00PM:	Break
2:00-2:15PM:	All students on stage
2:15-2:30PM:	T-shirts and certificates

How are the classes divided? There will be approximately forty five 5-6 year olds, divided into three groups of approximately 15 students based on age.

Can parents watch class? Because of limited seats at *Rapunzel*, there will only be one seat per student, so parents will not be able to attend the performance. Our classes are always open, but we do find that students are often more free creatively when not being observed. The best non-obtrusive place to observe is in top row of the theatre arena as the other classrooms are smaller and observation can distract the class in the smaller rooms.

What about food? Students bring their own lunch (no refrigerator available.) If they wish to bring a snack for breaks they may do so as well. Water and cups are provided.

What should I wear? Please wear comfortable clothes in which you can comfortably move. Please - no short skirts or open-toed shoes/sandals.

Who are the teachers? Director of DDP Children's Theatre/*Rapunzel* director Matt Wallace will teach Creative Dramatics; Actress and *Rapunzel* cast member Sandra Rivera will teach Dance; *Rapunzel* Musical Director Ronnie Breedlove will teach Music; DDP actress Carly Stotts will be our "principal."

How do I contact you? If there is an emergency and you need to reach a teacher or student during class time, please call the box office at 812-288-8281. If you need to reach us outside of class time, you can call the Education Department line at 812-288-2632, ex. 132 or email Matt at Wallace@derbydinner.com.

What is the cancellation policy? You may cancel one month in advance with no penalty and receive a full refund. If you cancel less than one month in advance, you will receive a refund ONLY if there is a waiting list and there is someone to take that open space. (There is usually a waiting list for all of our workshops and camps.)
