


a one-day "viewing and doing" summer camp for 5, 6 and 7 year-olds

What is the date and time? Friday, June 13, 2014 from 9:30AM-2:30PM

<u>Where do I go?</u> The day begins and finishes in the theatre arena at Derby Dinner Playhouse. Parking is free. The classes take place on stage, in the lobby, and in the lounge.

What is the schedule for the day?

9:30AM: Check-in, arrival and seating for performance

10:00-10:50AM: Students watch professional production of *Princess Penelope's Dragon*

10:50-11:00AM: Break

11:00-11:15AM: Post-performance discussion with the *Princess Penelope's Dragon* cast

11:15-11:30AM: Theatre tour

11:30AM-12:00PM: Lunch (students bring own lunch)

12:00-12:30PM: Acting, Music, or Dance

12:30-12:40PM: Break

12:40-1:10PM: Acting, Music, or Dance

1:10-1:20PM: Break

1:20-1:50PM: Acting, Music, or Dance

1:50-2:00PM: Break

2:00-2:15PM: All students on stage 2:15-2:30PM: T-shirts and certificates

<u>How are the classes divided?</u> There will be approximately forty five 5-6-7 year olds, divided into three groups of approximately 15 students based on age.

<u>Can parents watch class?</u> Because of limited seats at *Princess Penelope*, there will only be one seat per student, so parents will not be able to attend the performance. Parents are welcome to wait in the lobby during the show if they plan on staying. During the performance our teacher/chaperones will be with the students at all times. After the performance, the classes and tour will begin. We find that students do much better and are often more free creatively when not being observed by parents in class. The best non-obtrusive place to observe class is in the theatre arena as the other classrooms are smaller and it can disrupt class.

<u>What about food?</u> Students bring their own lunch (no refrigerator available.) If they wish to bring a snack for breaks they may do so as well. Water and cups are provided.

<u>What should I wear?</u> Please wear comfortable clothes in which you can comfortably move. Please - no short skirts or opentoed shoes/sandals.

<u>Who are the teachers?</u> All classes will be taught by DDP professionals. We will also have a very special guest from the *Princess Penelope's* cast!

<u>How do I contact you?</u> If there is an emergency and you need to reach a teacher or student during class time, please call the box office at 812-288-8281. If you need to reach us outside of class time, you can call the Education Department line at 812-288-2632, ex. 132 or email Tina Jo at Wallace@derbydinner.com.

What is the cancellation policy? You may cancel one month in advance with no penalty and receive a full refund. If you cancel less than one month in advance, you will receive a refund only if there is a waiting list, and there is someone to take that open space. If you cancel less than one week before the workshop date, no refund will be given. If we cancel the workshop day due to inclement weather, the workshop will be rescheduled for another date. If a workshop is canceled, we will email you and we will leave a recording at the Education Department extension – 812-288-2632, ex. 132. The box office will be notified as well. If we are unable to schedule another date, we will issue a refund or credit.

*NOTE – Due to the large number of people registering and to be fair, we cannot *save* spots for students over the phone or email. To register, we must receive the completed registration form and payment either in the mail or by dropping off at box office. If you pay with credit card and scan the document with payment info, we can accept as a PDF document via email as well.*
